



Health & Safety Policy

Dormansland Lawn Tennis Club is committed to providing a safe environment for all players, volunteers and coaches. It will promote standards of health, safety and welfare within tennis and will ensure compliance with all relevant statutory provisions. The Club will ensure that risk assessments are carried out, that procedures and safe systems are implemented in accordance with current statutory provisions and that reasonable and practical measures are taken to minimise risk.

Dormansland Lawn Tennis Club aims to, so far as is reasonably practicable:

- comply with all relevant health and safety legislation and guidelines;
- conduct risk assessments and implement actions arising to reduce identified risks;
- maintain and inspect courts and equipment;
- ensure safe storage/use of substances;
- seek to prevent accidents and incidents;
- report any accidents or incidents and ensure the timely completion of investigations to prevent re-occurrence;
- provide a first aid kit; and
- provide appropriate information to help all those involved in club activity to take care of their own safety and welfare and that of others.

Members of Dormansland Lawn Tennis Club have a duty to:

- take reasonable care for their own health & safety and that of others who may be affected by what they do or not do;
- co-operate with the Club on health and safety issues;
- correctly use all equipment provided by the Club;
- not interfere with or misuse anything provided for their health, safety or welfare.

The First Aid Kit is located in the clubhouse next to the kitchen sink, is inspected regularly, and is re-stocked as necessary.

The Club Committee is responsible for the implementation and management of health and safety arrangements that exist within Dormansland Lawn Tennis Club and accepts this responsibility.
